

# NI22/NI25 Supplement

## Using Appliance with the Doors Open



### General Usage

These appliances are designed to be used with the doors closed to achieve the outputs and efficiencies quoted in the product specification.

However the NI22 and NI25 can be used with the doors open without causing damage to the product, but will operate at reduced efficiency when doing so.

Under certain circumstances some smoke spillage may occur and if this happens the doors should be closed and the room ventilated to clear any smoke or fumes.

If it is intended to primarily use the stove with the doors open it is recommended to increase ventilation to the room above what is required for normal use to minimise any possible spillage problems.

### Recommended Ventilation

Recommended ventilation for open door use is:-

NI – 22	8850 mm <sup>2</sup>
NI – 25	12050 mm <sup>2</sup>



**WHEN INSTALLING AND COMMISSIONING THE STOVE IT IS IMPORTANT TO CONFIRM THE SUITABILITY FOR USE WITH THE DOORS OPEN BY COMPLETING A SPILLAGE TEST.**

As the stove was designed for closed use it cannot be guaranteed that the installation will be spillage free if used with the doors open. The provision of additional ventilation will help minimise the possibility of this.
